

AmeCon Artwork Bring and Buy 'Guidelines', Terms & Conditions

Important: A 5% fee will be taken by the convention to offset costs.

Items

You can sell any of your artwork the AmeCon bring and buy. Multiple copies of a single artwork can be sold. **Whilst the convention will try to monitor and protect displayed artwork, the convention cannot take responsibility if the artwork is damaged or stolen.**

Preparation

Please have your forms (they can be downloaded at www.amecon.org/apply_bringbuy.php) filled in and your items already stickered and labelled before you drop off. This will speed up the drop-off process, reducing queues and freeing up valuable convention time.

Your seller number for the Artwork Bring and Buy will be your registration number. **This is located in your registration email.** This needs to be written on your forms in the space provided along with your name and badge name for identification purposes.

Fill out the form provided clearly giving as much info as you feel required to describe your item and the sale price.

E.g.:	1	Sakura fan art	£10
	2	Full metal alchemist fan art Print	£20

You will note that each item also has an item number. 1, 2, 3, etc.

Once you have filled out the form you will need to use small **labels to identify your art.** These will need to include your **seller number (circled)** the **item number** that corresponds to the number on the form and finally the **price.** These labels will be displayed next to your artwork. That's it! Now you just sit back and enjoy the con while your art is (theoretically) sold for you.

Drop-off

For the Art Gallery your work can be dropped off at any time, or even created at the convention! However it will be easier to create an evocative and exciting display, and increase your chances of making a sale, if the artwork is available early.

Collection (Sellers)

As your art is sold the gophers will tick the boxes indicating so and display a "SOLD" notice next to your work when the final piece is sold.

You may collect at any time, **up-to 16:00 on Sunday**, but you will not be able to leave pieces on-sale after collecting.

You will need to sign that you have received payment, and any unsold pieces then a gopher will counter sign. Any problems should be raised with the gopher at this time.

After the convention any uncollected artwork will become the property of the convention. Uncollected money may be requested by email and will be sent by cheque at the convention's convenience. A £5 or 5% handling fee, whichever is larger, will be applied in addition to the 5% sales fee.

Collection (Buyers)

Due to the nature of the art gallery if your purchase is the last (or a unique!) piece of artwork you will not be able to pick up your purchase end of the con (to ensure the art gallery still has content!). Your details will be recorded and a time specified when you can collect your purchases, which you will then need to sign for.
